GENERAL CONDITIONS

- To qualify for the Sprockids program, the child must be 6 years old as of September 30, 2018; a proof of age may be required.
- Complete payment is required to confirm a registration at the Mountain Bike School, to obtain a season pass, a parking permit or to register for a race.
- An administrative fee of \$25, per participant, is charged for any cancellation or change.
- A refund or credit (prorated) may only be requested for a major medical reason or because of a relocation. Proofs required.
- No refund or credit is granted for an absence to a course, regardless of the reason.
- The Mountain Bike School reserves the right to change the schedule or to cancel a course.
- WEATHER – Light rain does not prevent the practice of mountain biking. If the Mountain Bike School has to interrupt a course due to heavy rain or thunderstorms, workshops will be offered indoors.
- Unless you request us not to do so, you authorize MONT RIGAUD to include you in our advertising and marketing campaigns.

RULES OF THE TRAILS

Rules developed by the *International Mountain Bicycling Association (IMBA)* to promote responsible and courteous conduct on shared-use trails:

1. Plan ahead.
2. Ride Open Trails.
3. Leave No Trace.
4. Control Your Bicycle and Wear Safety Equipment.
5. Yield Appropriately.
6. Respect Nature.

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the trails, always show courtesy to others. Observe the rules listed above and share with others the responsibility for a great outdoor experience. You must obey all other rules and signs pertaining to any particular activity as marked out by the station.

Know the rules. Be safety conscious. It is your responsibility!

The participant recognizes, accepts and assumes the inherent risks of mountain biking. The participant assumes all risks of personal injury or any material damage resulting from the said risks. Among others, the following lists the elements considered inherent risk to the normal practice of mountain biking:

changing climatic conditions, changes in the steepness of the trails, the presence of natural obstacles and any other natural features, such as ditches, crevices and brooks, rocks, earth, uncovered spots, trees, trees regrowth, natural bushes and stumps, and any other obstacles, any change to surface condition, collisions with cyclists or other persons, the presence of pylons, poles and any other structures used in the operation of the ski area and collisions with these elements.

The contract in virtue of which the present document was concluded is subject to the laws in force in Quebec. The Mountain Bike School registrants and holders of a season pass, as well as Mont Rigaud, agree to elect domicile in the judicial district of Beauharnois, province of Quebec and declare that same is the appropriate forum for any and all claims, of whatever nature, arising from the contract in virtue of which the present document was issued.

 The Bike School recommends that the student wear gloves, arm and leg pads;
 The parent/guardian/person responsible or participant has the responsibility to disclose to the school and to the instructor any pre-existing medical condition of the student that may have an impact on the mountain biking practice and on the inherent risks;

4. **SUPERVISION:**

I acknowledge that mountain biking take place over a large area, which means that the instructor is not close to his student(s) at all times and that he cannot directly intervene at all times;
 The instructor cannot maintain visual contact with his students(s) at all times;
